

WEDNESDAY NIGHT MIXED SINGLES

10 PIN SINGLES DROP-IN LEAGUE W/ HANDICAP

GENERAL

This is a drop-in league with **no commitment** to bowling every week.

This league will be handicapped, with handicap being 90% of 230.

The league will be a singles league with each bowler bowling 3 games a night.

Prebowls are **not** allowed.

This is a house league run by Mario's Bowl. All stats and financial records will be recorded by Mario's Bowl and will be available at the request of any bowler in the league.

The league bowls Wednesday nights with scoring starting at 7:30 P.M. Practice 15 minutes prior The league will run from 4 series; each series will consist of 2 oil patterns changed after week 4.

Series 1 -- Sept 3 – Oct 22 consisting of 8 weeks.

Series 2 –Oct 29 – Dec 17 consisting of 8 weeks.

Series 3 – Jan 7 – Feb 25 consisting of 8 weeks.

Series 4 – Mar 4 – Apr 22 consisting of 8 weeks.

MEMBERSHIP

All CTF general playing rules not covered will be observed. This league <u>will</u> be sanctioned. A \$30 CTF registration will cover all year. For anyone who has a CTF card from another league this season will only need to fill out a registration form without payment.

COST

Weekly bowling fee: \$25 per bowler per night.

\$20 will go to linage & \$5 to Prize fund.

There will be no shortages allowed in this league. You pay to play.

ENTERING AVERAGE

Bowlers will use the following criteria for their entering average in order:

- 1) Last year's final league average, minimum 21 games.
- 2) Highest final sanctioned average from 2024-25 bowling season, minimum 21 games
- 3) Highest final average from any league in the 2024-25 bowling season, minimum 21 games
- 4) Highest current sanctioned average from the 2025-26 bowling season, minimum 21 games
- 5) Highest current average from any league in the 2025-26 bowling season, minimum 21 games
- 6) Highest available average from any season.
- New bowlers without an available average may still bowl using an average calculated using their 1st week 3 game total. League averages will be calculated after 3 games bowled.

If you have bowled any games in a previous series of this league your average will carry over to the new series and reset after your first 3 games bowled in the new series.

Your Sanctioned CTF average will be the total games bowled through all 4 series.

CONTINUED REVERSE

POINTS

Points will be calculated by regressive handicapped 3 game total, 1st place total receives maximum points, 2nd place receives 1 less point than 1st place, 3rd place receives 1 less point than 2nd and so on until the last place player receives 1 point. Maximum Points will be the total # of bowlers out each week.

Bonus high game with handicap scores will be awarded points to the top 1/3 of the bowlers in a regressive format as well. Ex. If 24 bowlers are out, High Game will Receive 8 points, 2nd place receives 1 less point than 1st place, 3rd place receives 1 less point than 2nd etc.

LANE ASSIGNMENTS

Bowlers will be allowed to bowl with whomever they choose. If a pair only has 2 bowlers, 1 bowler may be asked to move from a pair who has 5 or more, or the 3 bowlers will be spread out across existing lanes who have 4 -7 bowlers.

No Bowler will be allowed to bowl on the same pair as the week previous. Unless unavoidable from previous rule.

A simple pair to the right strategy will be in place so if you bowled 3-4 last week you will bowl 5-6 this week.

PAYOUT AND PRIZES

for each series players who win these awards will receive

High Average - \$20.00 (eligible bowlers must bowl at least 6 weeks to qualify.)

High Scratch Single - \$20.00 (eligible bowlers must bowl at least 4 weeks to qualify.)

High Scratch Triple - \$20.00 (eligible bowlers must bowl at least 4 weeks to qualify.)

High Handicap Single - \$20.00 (eligible bowlers must bowl at least 4 weeks to qualify.)

High Handicap Triple - \$20.00 (eligible bowlers must bowl at least 4 weeks to qualify.)

Each player is only eligible to win 1 of these awards per series.

If no one qualifies for an award because of the lack of weeks bowled the prize money will be paid out with the points.

The remainder of the prize fund will be paid based on points. A price per point will be calculated after all the points have been tallied and the prize fund has been confirmed. Payouts will be rounded to the nearest quarter(\$0.25), Any payouts that fall below \$4.00 and any rounding will be carried over to the final night of bowling.

Payouts will occur the week **following** the final week of each series and can be picked up from our front desk. Every bowler will receive at least 1 point each week they are out, so every bowler will receive a portion of the prize fund.

Standings will be posted online at www.mariosbowl.com as well as in the bowling center.

All CTF Rules not covered will be followed.
