

BOWL CANADA CUP RULES & INFORMATION

MARIO'S BOWL

Entry for all league members is FREE! for the League Qualifying Round!

1/2 of the teams entered in the League Qualifying Round will be eligible to advance to the House Cup Round. Use your average from the league night you are bowling. If you bowl in multiple leagues, which ever league you are bowling in, use that average (do not have to use highest of all leagues in this round only). Bowlers must be 19 years of age or older as of April 1, 2018 to enter. Bowlers must have 21 games in the league they are qualifying in. League spares are eligible if they meet the game requirements in that current league. Members of YBC are eligible if they meet the age requirement.

This tournament is pins over average format for all rounds

LEAGUE QUALIFYING ROUND - JANUARY 15 TO FEBRUARY 4

Teams must be declared prior to that nights bowling.

Scores will be used from your league indicated. If bowlers are on different teams, league scores will be automatically taken from their league teams for the scoreboard.

Prebowls *will* count for league qualifying scores.

WEEK 1 - JANUARY 15 - 21 - All league teams are entered automatically with their lineup used on the league night during this week. Teams that do not have the correct amount of bowlers corresponding to the tournament format (5 pin - 5 person teams, 10 pin - 4 person teams) will need to be adjusted prior to bowling. Sheets will be handed out to each to team to verify their bowlers. REMINDER – THIS ROUND IS FREE TO ENTER

For 10 pin, leagues that have 5 person teams will have to decide which 4 members will compete before bowling begins.

For 5 pin, leagues that have 4 person teams can make their own teams using bowlers only from their league the first week. If there are teams with absent bowlers, use the present members from that team to add to other teams to make the 5th member.

If a bowler is absent this week, use 95% of their average for an absentee score. Vacant bowlers are not to be used for qualifying and can be filled with another league member

WEEKS 2&3 - JANUARY 22 – FEBRUARY 4 - Teams may re-enter the same team from their league (highest of all weeks POA score will count for re-entered team) or make their own team using bowlers from any league. *Changing one person on a team from the previous week will constitute a new team/entry.* If using bowlers from other leagues, names must be submitted prior to the first league bowling. I.E. John & Mary from Monday night will be bowling with Jill & Larry from Thursday night. Entry form must be submitted with all 4 names on Monday night before John & Mary bowl. No vacancies shall be used. Teams must have full amount of bowlers (including prebowls).

MARIO'S BOWL

HOUSE CUP ROUND

Averages for all bowlers will be updated as of the date of the House Cup Round that is being bowled. The highest average from all leagues (minimum 21 games) will be used.

4 games will be bowled and cost will be \$30 per bowler.

Substitutions can be made at this round but the each team bowler must meet eligibility requirements and must have participated in the league qualifying round on any team. You are limited to 2 substitutions per team for the House Cup. The bowlers whose scores were used in the League Qualifying are the ones that must bowl on the team competing in the House Cup. If a bowler is absent for the House Cup, 95% of the average will be used. Only 1 vacancy/absentee is allowed per team. Full team entry must be paid for each team regardless of absentees.

One team spot minimum will be awarded to 5 pin and 10 pin. All other spots advancing will be determined on a 1:6 ration (1 team advancing for every 6 teams entered). If a single House Cup round has a minimum of 12 teams, the winning team from that round will automatically advance. All other advancing teams will be determined by combining the scores from all shifts into one scoreboard.

5 Pin - 3 shifts available:

Sun, Feb 11 – 10:00 a.m.

Sun, Feb 18 – 10:00 a.m.

Sat, Feb 24 – 2:30 p.m.

10 Pin - 3 shifts available:

Sun, Feb 11 – 6:00 p.m.

Sat, Feb 17 – 1:00 p.m.

Sun, Feb 25 – 6:00 p.m.

(12 teams max for each shift 5 pin, 16 teams max for each shift 10 pin, first come, first served)

If a bowler qualifies for the provincial round on more than one team, he/she must declare which team they will be participating with immediately after qualifying with the 2nd team. If the 2nd team also qualifies for the provincial round, a replacement for the bowler that withdrew for the other team can be used for the provincials but the bowler must have participated in the House Cup Round.

5 Pin Provincials - Saturday, April 14, 2018 – Mario's Bowl & Superior Bowladrome

10 Pin Provincials - Saturday, April 28, 2018 - Mario's Bowl

5 games will be rolled at the 10 pin provincials, 6 games will be bowled at the 5 pin provincials (3 games at Mario's, 3 games at Superior). Lineage will be paid by the proprietors. Averages will be updated to use bowlers highest average as of April 1, 2018 (minimum 21 games) in all leagues. The winning team from each event (5 & 10 pin) will advance to the Bowl Canada Cup National Finals in Edmonton.
