APPLICATION DEADLINE: Tuesday, October 14, 2025. Late entries will only be accepted to fill the lane draw.

ELIGIBILITY: This tournament is open to all bowlers who are twelve (12) years of age and not yet nineteen (19) years of age as of December 31, 2025 and are either a member of the YBC or the C5PBA.

PROVINCIAL CHAMPIONSHIPS: Bowlers who qualify for the provincial championship will be responsible for the payment of the provincial entry fee of \$50.00, the purchase of a TBD5PBA zone shirt (if required) at a cost of \$50.00 (for first shirt, \$80.00 for each shirt after), and will be required to participate in the Bowl for Kids fundraiser by collecting a minimum of \$10.00 in pledges. The Provincial Round will take place on December 6, 2025 at Mid-Town Bowl in Timmins, ON.

WAIVER OF LIABILITY: The C5PBA and the host committee undertake no responsibility for damages or injuries suffered by bowlers. As a condition of and in consideration of the entries in these championships, all competitors shall be deemed to agree to assume all risks of injuries to the competitor's person and property resulting from, or caused by or connected with the conduct and management of competitions and to release any and all claims that they may have against the officials, the association and the host committee and against their officers, and their entries shall be accepted only on these conditions.

GENERAL RULES OF CONDUCT FOR THE 2025-2026 YOUTH CHALLENGE

To be eligible a bowler must:

1. Be twelve (12) years of age and not yet nineteen (19) years of age as of December 31, 2025 who are a member of the YBC, or a C5PBA member
2. Properly complete the entry form for the event, complete with parent and guardian's signature, if required, giving the bowler permission to compete in the zone and Provincial Roll-Offs, should the entrant advance that far.
3. The Parent/guardian, or the entrant by signing this form, absolves this association and its affiliates from any and all legal responsibilities for any personal injury sustained by the entrant during the time the entrant is traveling to, and competing in or traveling from these competitions.

GENERAL RULES

1. Entry fee is \$60.00 for the Qualifying Roll-Offs which is five (5) games.
2. Entry Form must be submitted to a Thunder Bay Bowling Centre or to the Tournament Director no later than 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, October 14, 2025. **Late entries will be accepted only to fill out the lane draw.**
3. Entry fee may be paid with this form (cash or money order), online through our website (www.tbd5pba.ca), or at the tournament (cash, money order, Visa, or MasterCard). NO CHEQUES PLEASE. All payments by Visa or MasterCard will have an automatic 3% processing fee.
4. The Qualifying Roll-Offs will be held at Mario's Bowl on Sunday, October 19, 2025 commencing at 9:30 a.m.
5. There will be a 15-minute warm-up prior to the start of bowling.
6. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages or drugs may be used by the bowlers before, during or after play. The penalty for such use will be immediate suspension from further competition for at least one (1) year and will mean the disqualification of that bowler. This includes any bowler who may have turned 19 after December 31, 2024.
7. No food or drinks will be allowed in the bowler's enclosure.
8. The top 7 men and top 7 ladies plus top 8th place man or woman based on total pinfall in their qualifying round shall qualify for Men's, Ladies' and Mixed teams advancing to the **Provincial Championships which will be held December 6, 2025 at Mid-Town Bowl in Azilda, ON.**
9. All competitors qualifying for the zone teams will participate in the singles competition at the Provincial Championships. The top three ladies and the top three men will qualify for the C5PBA National Championship to be held from at the March 24th – 29th, 2026 in Edmonton, Alberta. The package price for those qualifying for Nationals is \$500.
10. In the event of a tie for 5th place (to determine who makes the Men's Team versus the Mixed Team) or 8th place (to determine who makes the Mixed Team versus the runner-up), a one (1) game Roll-Off will be held to determine the final placing.
11. Coaches for the Men's, Ladies and Mixed Teams will be selected by the Teams at the end of this tournament
12. Any bowler whose wearing apparel is deemed by the Judge of Play to be obscene by picture or printed word will be disqualified from further play.
13. The use of foul language during any level of these competitions will disqualify the bowler from further play. This includes practices and travel as well as during the competition itself.
14. The uniform to be worn at the Provincial and National level must include black dress pants. (not provided)
15. Canadian 5 Pin Bowlers association rules will be in effect should any dispute arise which is not covered above. The decision of the Tournament Director will be Final.
