INSTRUCTIONS

1. Complete the attached application form
2. READ THE ATTACHED GUIDELINES AND EXPECTATIONS CAREFULLY! (Page 4 of this package)
3. If you do not have your NCCP# or C5PBA# do not worry - we can get it
4. Submit the completed form to Wesley Swoluk, Tournament Director, when completed, by leaving at Superior Bowladrome to his attention, by email at waswoluk@lakeheadu.ca (both prior to the day of the tournament) or at the host centre (if applying the day of the tournament)
5. **LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.** Should you wish to enter your name as a coach, it must be done prior to the start of the tournament. If we don't have enough coaches by the deadline, teams without a coach will be able to approach any qualified coach for their team.
6. For the **YOUTH CHALLENGE** and **OPEN**, coaches must have their Competitive Coaching certificate and must have completed their training 30 days prior to the provincial round.
7. For the **POA CLASSIC**, Community Sport coaches may be chosen.
8. Please pay close attention to the tournament dates. Do not apply to coach a tournament if you aren't available for all of the stages.

COACHES GUIDELINES, RESPONSIBILITIES, AND DUTIES

1. All coaches must be fully certified Competitive Coach for Youth Challenge and Open coaching and Community Sport for POA Classic prior to being selected and must be a C5PBA member
2. All Youth Challenge Coaches and Managers must participate in the Bowl for Kids fundraiser
3. All Coaches and Managers must sell four (4) Northern Ontario Lottery Tickets @ \$20.00 each
4. Be able to communicate with the team
5. Promote feedback from the team members
6. Be authoritative with the team
7. Try to control the team
8. Set an example for the team
9. Be responsible for the team conduct.
10. Limit practice times to 1 or 2 hours
11. Meet with the Manager of the contingent to review Rules and Regulations of the competition
12. Have a team meeting prior to the start of practise to set out the goals, objectives and to review the rules and regulations of the competition.
13. Be prepared to request in writing the suspension of any bowler whose actions/conduct either on or off the lanes can be established as detrimental to the team's progress through any competition or whose actions/conduct are not in the best interests of the Thunder Bay District or Northern Ontario 5 Pin Bowlers' Association and will be dealt with at the next meeting of the body.
